READING WITH UNDERSTANDING CAMPAIGN IN ATAL ADARSH/NAVYUG and NDMC AIDED SCHOOLS FOR THE STUDENTS OF CLASSES III TO VIII TO ACHIEVE PROFICIENCY AMONG ALL THE STUDENTS OF NDMC SCHOOLS

NIPUN Bharat Mission (National Initiative for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy) is launched by the Education Ministry of India under National Education Policy-2020.

NIPUN Bharat focuses on transforming the monotonous education system into an integrated, enjoyable, all inclusive and engaging endeavors.

As per NEP 2020 this policy will become relevant for our students only if the most basic learning requirement Reading accurately with understanding and expression is achieved.

However, National Achievement Survey 2017 has stated that in all over India 13-18% students from Class 3,5 and 8 are below basic learning levels and only 39.53% have achieved proficiency.

It is also being felt that student's reading with understanding, proficiency needs urgent attention due to lack of classes on physical mode in the academic session 2020-21 and 2021-22.

To fill the learning gaps a summer camp for the students of NDMC and Navyug Schools was organized from 11th May to 3rd June 2022 with the objective of enhancing reading skills with understanding. During the summer camp, learning was imparted through various participative/enjoyable and engaging learning activities.

In continuation of momentum generated during summer camp a "Reading With Understanding Campaign" will be organized for the students of classes 3^{rd} to 8^{th} as per the following schedule:-
